


1. Blow up the balloon.



2. Rub the balloon with wool or terry cloth. This moves positive+ electrons to the balloon. Now it will move light weight things.



 Move the charged balloon close to the can to pull it without touching.



(Living animals might choke on your balloon before it decomposes. Make sure to cut it into small pieces and throw away in a sealed bag, like your home garbage.)

Earliest balloons were made from animal intestines, and twisted into animal shapes!
