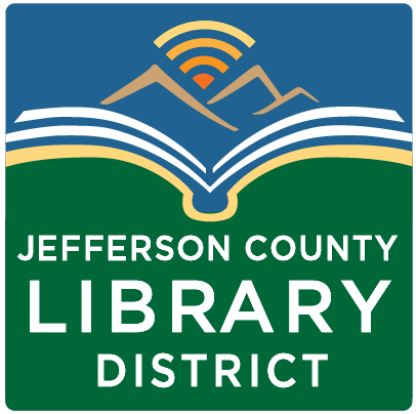

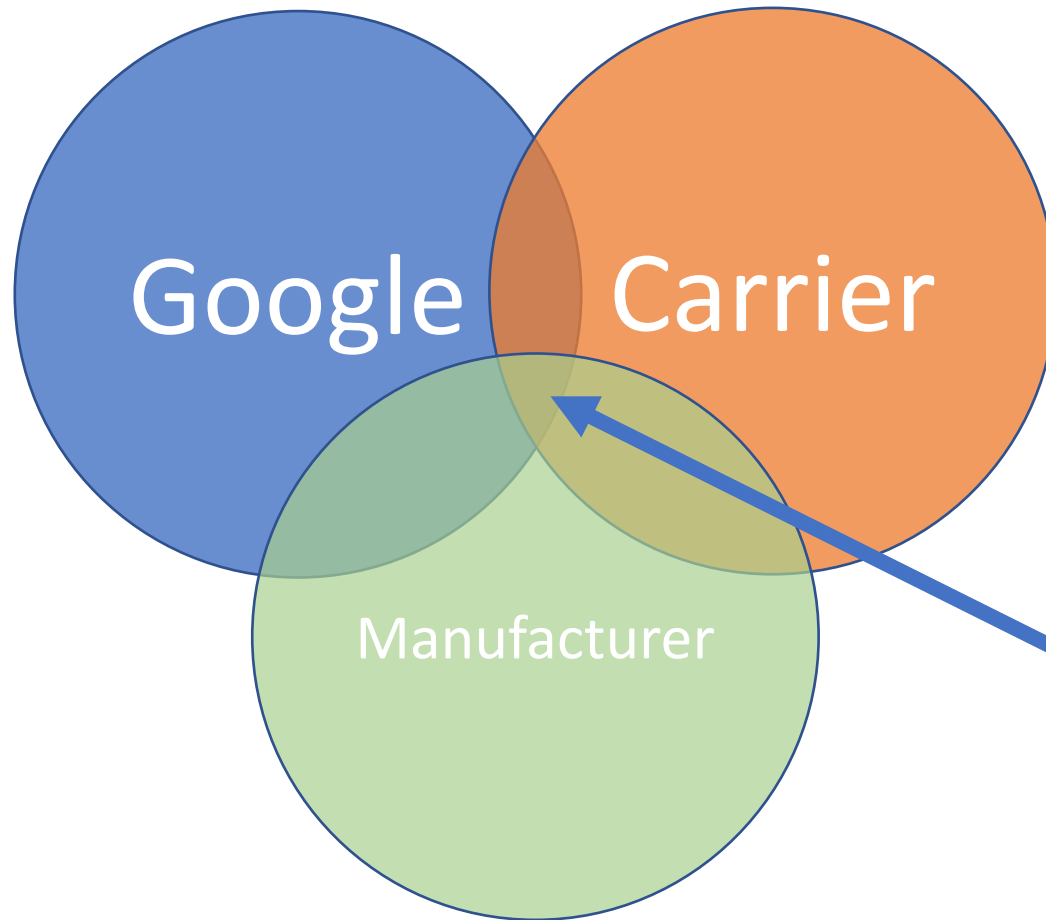

Gestures, Buttons and Layout

1. Swipe, Tap Press and Hold.
2. Buttons - Physical and Virtual
3. Lock Screen – Wake up the phone
4. Notification
5. Pin/Passwords/FaceID...
6. Home Screen
 1. Notification Area and quick settings
 2. Widgets
 3. Apps
7. Play Store – where you go to get apps
