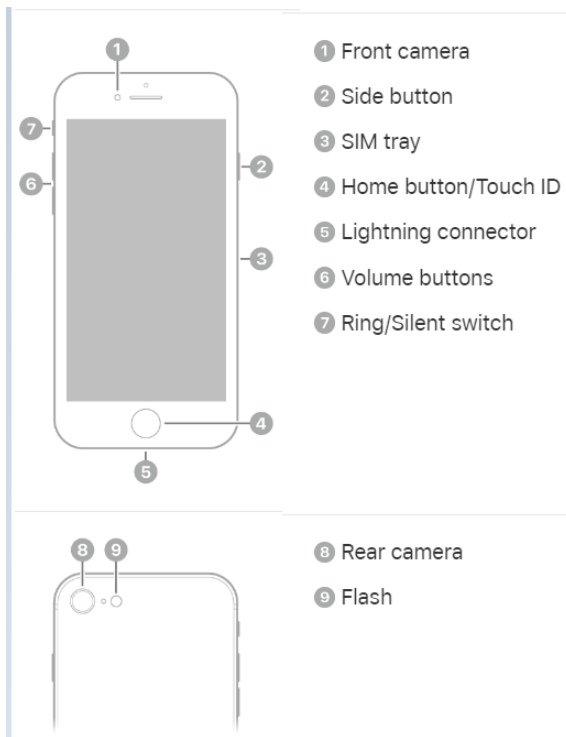

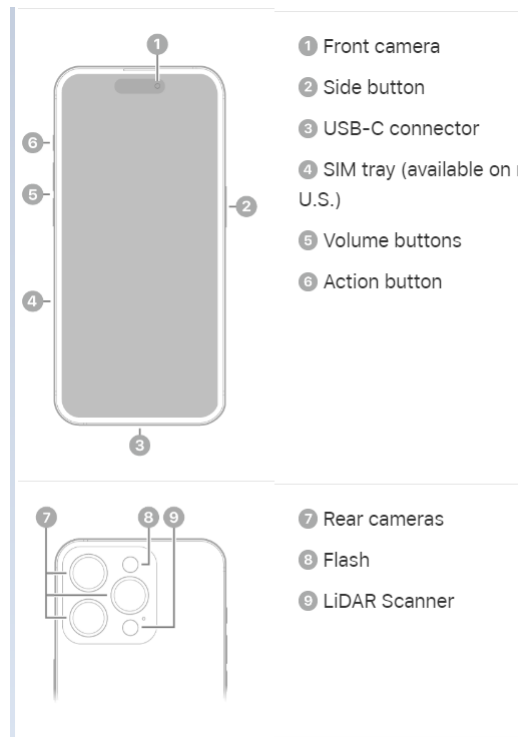

Tech Tuesday – iPhone Basics

Learn basic gestures to interact with iPhone

Control iPhone and its apps using a few simple gestures—tap, touch and hold, swipe, scroll, and zoom.

Symbol	Gesture
	Tap. Briefly touch an item on the screen with one finger. For example, to open an app, tap its icon on the Home Screen.
	Touch and hold. Press an item on the screen until something happens. For example, if you touch and hold the wallpaper of the Home Screen, the app icons begin to jiggle.
	Swipe. Move one finger across the screen quickly. For example, swipe left on the Home Screen to see more apps.
	Scroll. Move one finger across the screen without lifting. For example, in Photos, you can drag a list up or down to see more. Swipe to scroll quickly; touch the screen to stop scrolling.
	Zoom. Place two fingers on the screen near each other. Spread them apart to zoom in, or move them toward each other to zoom out. You can also double-tap a photo or webpage to zoom in, and double-tap again to zoom out. In Maps, double-tap and hold, then drag up to zoom in or drag down to zoom out.

Settings:

1. About your phone :
 - a. Settings > General > About
 - b. Your Account Apple ID

2. Display and Brightness (Search Display Settings)
 - a. Screen Brightness
 - b. Time to Autolock
 - c. Text Size
 - d. Auto Zoom


3. Control Center (Search Control Center)
 - a. *On an iPhone with Face ID:* Swipe down from the top-right edge. To close Control Center, swipe up from the bottom.
 - b. *On an iPhone with a Home button:* Swipe up from the bottom. To close Control Center, swipe down or press the Home button.

Contacts (Search Contacts)

1. Adding a contact
2. Searching Contacts
3. Birthdays
4. Phone and Text
5. Maps

Making and receiving Calls (Search Call)

1. Turn Ringer on and off
 - a. *On iPhone 15 Pro and iPhone 15 Pro Max:* [Open Control Center](#), then tap 
 - b. *On other models:* Flip the Ring/Silent switch to turn Silent mode on or off.
2. Call a contact or type in a number
3. Speaker Phone
4. Redial
5. Conference Call

Part 2

Using the Camera to take a picture

1. Open the camera app
2. Switch between front and back cameras
3. Capture photo
 - a. Shutter button or volume buttons
4. Camera modes
5. Zoom in and out
6. Arrow at top for more options

Using Photos to View, Edit, and Share

1. Open the photos app
2. Tap to open photo
 - a. Share
 - b. Favorite
 - c. Info
 - d. Delete
 - e. Edit
3. Select multiple photos

Using Messages to text

1. Add a photo
 - a. Yourself
 - i. Edit > Name & Photo > Edit
 - ii. Settings > Messages > Share Name and Photo > Edit
 - b. A contact

- i. Tap on their circle > Info > Edit > Add Photo
2. Pin a favorite
 - a. Touch and hold over message > Pin
3. Search messages
 - a. Type into search box at the top
 - b. Tap microphone and then speak
4. Reply to messages
5. Create a new message

Surfing the web

1. Setup Safari – in settings
 - a. Choose your search engine
 - b. Block pop ups
 - c. Tabs
 - d. Cross-site tracking
2. Edit homepage
3. Add favorites
4. Searching using Google
5. Navigate Safari
 - a. Tab bar
 - b. Refresh page
 - c. View open tabs
 - d. Private browsing
 - e. Sharing
