Bookmobile Services: The District will provide access to information to many of those who live at a distance from the Library through Bookmobile Service. Potential and present stops throughout the County will be evaluated for levels of service, desirable service, and cessation of service by the Library Director on an annual basis. Staff, operating, and equipment funds are included in the annual budget. All policies established for the District will apply to the Bookmobile Service.

Other Outreach Services: Library Service to the homebound, nutrition sites, community centers, day care centers, or the County Jail may be coordinated by the Director with the sponsoring agencies. Book deposits may be used where deemed appropriate. Programs may be set up to reach the homebound, and other programs may be sponsored by the District which will promote the use of libraries and encourage reading. Funds for this purpose may be included in the annual operating budget.
